

Content Filtering

Description:

The ICN offers a centralized content filtering solution that allows constituents to purchase filtering services without the need for premise equipment or technical expertise on site. The ICN will use the combined purchasing power of its constituents and technical ability of the ICN staff to make a quality filtering solution affordable and available to constituents who desire it. The service provides low cost, easy to administer filtering with ICN reliability.

Technical Overview:

Filtering equipment will be located on the ICN backbone and maintained by ICN staff. Constituent host computers will be directed to filtering equipment by the router located at the constituent site (WCCP) or by configuring constituent host computers to use a proxy. The Constituent Administrator will make all filtering decisions for that institution through a simple and intuitive Web administration tool.

What's Included:

- Licenses
- Router Configuration (for ICN managed routers)
- One Constituent Administrator user name and password
- Web administration portal for Constituent Administrator to select filtering options
- Training and assistance for Constituent Administrator with initial set up of filtering options
- Ongoing support for Constituent Administrator
- 24 hour support

Cost:

Installation (per institution, non-recurring)	\$500.00
Filtering Service (per computer, per month, one year commitment)	45 cents

- Configuration of individual host computers
- End user support
